School Management
School's Major Concerns: Harmony in Diversity
School Management Organisation: Whole-school Approach of intertwined network of longitudinal Functional Groups and latitudinal Form Teacher Groups.
Incorporated Management Committee / School Management Committee / Management Committee: The School Management Committee is formed by representatives of the school sponsoring body and experienced educationalists. Members of the SMC are enthusiastic about education. With appropriate expectation, they actively lead the school as supervisors and supporters.
School Green Policy: Inter-class recycling competition is organized to enhance students' awareness in environmental protection.
Learning and Teaching Plan
Whole-school Language Policy: English is used as the medium of instruction for all subjects except for Chinese Language and Chinese History.
Learning and Teaching Strategies: Student-oriented learning approach with variety of life-wide learning activities. Provision of school-based curriculum and relevant elective subjects with small-scale group teaching pedagogy in line with students' interest and ability. Daily reading session to nurture students' habit of free voluntary reading.
School-based Curriculum: 1. Electives: 3X. Basically three electives are required in NSS. Students may switch one elective into ApL course (Mode 2) according to their interest. 2. Curriculum highlights: Curriculum adaption in Chinese Language is implemented in all forms to cater for learner diversity. Tailor-made curriculum is also implemented in NSS Mathematics.
Major Renewed Emphases in the School Curriculum: Provide tablet computers to students and implement school-based eLearning project.
Life Planning Education: Programmes and Activities are planned for: 1. exploring students' potential through enhancing self-understanding; 2. investigating opportunities ahead; 3. developing life plan and managing changes and 4. Continuous development: build up a quality career guidance programme to cater for Non-Chinese Speaking students' needs.
Student Support
Whole School Approach to Catering for Learner Diversity: Our school has set up a Student Support Team to cater to learners' diversity and promote mutual respect of individuals' differences among students, as well as cultivate an inclusive school culture. The team consists of the Vice-principal, Special Educational Needs Coordinator (SENCO), Guidance Master, Social Workers, experienced teachers, and professionals like educational psychologists, clinical psychologists, and speech therapists. It conducts early identification and early intervention for students with special needs, and encourages teachers to adopt different teaching approaches to meet the diverse student needs in regular classrooms. By using the Learning Support Grant and Grant for Supporting NCS Students with SEN, the school adopts various accommodation measures to facilitate student development, such as personal coaching and tutorials, various training courses (e.g., phonics, social and communication skills, executive functioning, study skills, etc.), on-site speech therapy, on-site consultation with educational psychologists and clinical psychologists, social adaptation activities, special examination and homework arrangements, and even individual educational plans if necessary. Regular case meetings are held for teachers and parents to better understand different students' needs and evaluate the support measures for both the academic and student support domains. Understanding and catering to learners' diversity workshops are offered regularly during teacher development days.
Whole School Approach to Integrated Education: Teaching adaptation and assessment accommodation, remedial learning groups, training on social skills, speech therapy services, mechanism in soliciting parents' views and discussion on student progress.
Education Support for Non-Chinese Speaking (NCS) Students: Our school provides additional support for NCS students to facilitate their learning of Chinese: providing after-school support programmes in learning Chinese; appointing additional teacher(s)/teaching assistant(s) to support NCS students' learning of Chinese; arranging intensive Chinese learning and teaching mode(s), e.g. pull-out learning if necessary, split-class/group learning, etc.; developing school-based Chinese Language curriculum and/or adapting learning and teaching materials; organising activities to create an inclusive learning environment in the school; and hiring additional manpower and/or translation/interpretation services to facilitate the communication with parents of NCS students.
Measures to Provide Adaptation for Learning and Assessment: Mixture of criterion referencing and summative measurements for assessment.
Fee Remission: Our school offers full school fee remission or 1/2 school fee remission Needy students, including those from families receiving the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) and students receiving financial assistance provided by the Student Finance Office of the Working Family and Student Financial Assistance Agency (WFSFAA), could apply for fee remission. - Please visit the web-link in our school's website for details of school fee remission scheme, including the family income limits.
